Flutist Gina Eichman, graduate of the Peabody Conservatory of the Johns Hopkins University, has been a member of the Annapolis Symphony for over 20 years. She teaches flute privately in Howard County and her students have gone on to successful musical and professional lives.

Victoria Ritter, oboe, is a prominent freelancer in the DC, Maryland, and Pennsylvania area. In addition to performing, she is an accomplished private instructor who teaches students of all ages with an emphasis on beginning level to pre-college.

Clarinetist Paul Quinn is an active performer and educator in the Baltimore area and has performed extensively throughout Maryland, Pennsylvania, and Ohio. His primary teachers have included Burt Hara, Ron Samuels, and Jack Howell.

Kenneth Bell, Professor of Horn at Gettysburg College, is an alumnus of the US Marine Band and the Army Field Band. He has played assistant first horn with the Baltimore Symphony since 2000, and is also Operations Manager and first horn of the Baltimore Chamber Orchestra.

Bassoonist Monica Schwartz, graduate of the Peabody Conservatory and owner of Orchard Music Studios, has performed with wind quintets regularly for twenty-five years. She teaches private bassoon at Orchard Music and is on the faculty for the Peabody Preparatory.
